The District has seasonal positions available to staff hand crews, Type 6, and Type 3 Engines for local, regional and national deployments. Type 6 and type 3 seasonal positions available include both crew member and Engine Boss. Seasonal Wildland firefighters provide initial and sustained fire attack capabilities to the District. In addition to deployments, seasonal firefighters may perform mitigation or project work, monthly training, and equipment and fire apparatus readiness.

- **Successfully complete an arduous pack test (pack test renewal scheduled for February 18, 2012)**
- **Successfully pass a pre-employment medical exam/drug screen (at District Expense)**
